SMART IRRIGATION SYSTEM :

The team “INIT GCT” worked on the project titled “SMART IRRIGATION SYSTEM” under the theme “Empowerment of Villages Through Technologies” .

The fields of farmers are situated miles away from their home. Sometimes they need to go to their fields for several times in a day to start and stop the irrigation water pumps. Power is yet a limited resource in many parts of the villages around India. So, the farmers find it difficult to protect the crops from the unconditional rain. No one-stop solution exists for power, unconditional natural calamities and water problems. Through this project “Smart Irrigation System” we developed a device that can monitor the moisture content of the soil and turn on the water pump automatically whenever the moisture drops below a threshold value. Failure loop handle back is designed to rectify the failures. The main aim of this project is to demonstrate the economic feasibility of advanced computerized production technologies. The technology also allows to use smart mobile (via app) to control farm field activities through Internet/Wireless Network.

FUTURE OF RETAIL STORES – AMAZON GO

“No Lines, no Checkout – just grab and go.”

Amazon Go is a new kind of store with no checkout required. Amazon has created this retail store with a 'just walk out technology'. They created the world's most advanced shopping technology so you never have to wait in line. With this Just Walk Out Shopping experience, simply use the Amazon Go app to enter the store, take the products you want, and go! No lines, no checkout. (No, seriously.)

Technologies such as computer vision, sensor fusion and deep learning that underlines Amazon Go, is largely used in self driving cars. Just the way self driven cars are loaded with sensors to make it learn how to drive, Amazon Go stores use cameras to track a user's action in the store. This is where computer vision plays a crucial role, allowing computers to process visual information and generate appropriate algorithms based on the data that is gathered, to generate relevant results. The patent filed by the company reveals that it would use a system of cameras, sensors and/or RFID readers to identify shoppers and the items they've chosen. It also suggests that from the time a buyer enters into the store to the time he checks out, cameras take photos of various actions essentially when they enter store, while removing items and while keeping the items back in shelf. The second important part of the overall working is the Sensor Fusion, which is essentially an amalgamation of sensor data from a number of inputs, such as weight and motion sensors. When paired with computer vision, it helps in determining if someone has picked an item or placed it back. The final part comes in the form of deep learning, a part of machine learning that enables computers to learn by continuously collecting and analysing digital data. Combining these three tech advancements pulls out the best of Amazon Go.

This Just Walk Out Technology automatically detects when products are taken from or returned to the shelves and keeps track of them in a virtual cart. When you're done shopping, you can just leave the store. A little later, they'll send you a receipt and charge your Amazon account.

BLOCKCHAIN

A blockchain is, in the simplest of terms, a time-stamped series of immutable record of data that is managed by cluster of computers not owned by any single entity. Each of these blocks of data (i.e. block) are secured and bound to each other using cryptographic principles (i.e. chain). The blockchain network has no central authority – it is the very definition of a democratized system. Since it is a shared and immutable ledger, the information in it is open for anyone and everyone to see. Hence, anything that is built on the blockchain is by its very nature transparent and everyone involved is accountable for their actions.

The reason why the blockchain has gained so much admiration is that:

It is not owned by a single entity, hence it is decentralized

The data is cryptographically stored inside

The blockchain is immutable, so no one can tamper with the data that is inside the blockchain

The blockchain is transparent so one can track the data if they want to

The Three Pillars of Blockchain Technology:

Decentralization

Transparency

Immutability

Maintaining the Blockchain – Network and Nodes:

The blockchain is maintained by a peer-to-peer network. The network is a collection of nodes which are interconnected to one another. Nodes are individual computers which take in input and performs a function on them and gives an output. The blockchain uses a special kind of network called “peer-to-peer network” which partitions its entire workload between participants, who are all equally privileged, called “peers”. There is no longer one central server, now there are several distributed and decentralized peers.

Who Will Use The Blockchain?

Currently, finance offers the strongest use cases for the technology. International remittances, for instance. The World Bank estimates that over \$430 billion US in money transfers were sent in 2015. And at the moment there is a high demand for blockchain developers. The blockchain potentially cuts out the middleman for these types of transactions. Personal computing became accessible to the general public with the invention of the Graphical User Interface (GUI), which took the form of a “desktop”. Similarly, the most common GUI devised for the blockchain are the so-called “wallet” applications, which people use to buy things with Bitcoin, and store it along with other cryptocurrencies.

Transactions online are closely connected to the processes of identity verification. It is easy to imagine that wallet apps will transform in the coming years to include other types of identity management.

Fold-out phones can be the new big thing taking over the smartphone market.

The names of well-known tech giants including Samsung, Microsoft, LG, and Nokia were on everyone's lips as they all applied for patents for the design of foldable phones. Samsung, after declaring the launch of its first bendable handset in this year, has taken the lead in the race

“THE SAMSUNG FOLD” (\$1,980) On the front there is a 4.6-inch HD+ Super AMOLED (21:9) display, but open the phone up will find a 7.3-inch QXGA+(QHD+) Dynamic AMOLED (4:2:3) Infinity Flex display which transforms the phone into a tablet.

It packs 12GB of RAM and a high-end 7nm processor.

It also comes with 512GB of internal storage and support for USF (Universal Flash Storage), allowing handset to read data more faster. No expandable storage option.

It runs Android 9 pie, the latest software from google, but Samsung has developed a unique interface over the top to work especially with the screens.

It supports 3 multi-tasking, allowing you to have three apps open on the display at the same time.

Whatsapp and Microsoft Office have been specially adapted to work with the Galaxy Fold's 7.3-inch display.

It has a total of six cameras, with three on the rear (16MP + 12MP + 12MP), a 10MP selfie snapper on the front and two (10MP + 8MP) above the display inside.

The OLED display is the biggest differentiator that can allow foldable phones to have a strong impact on swathes of the smartphone market.

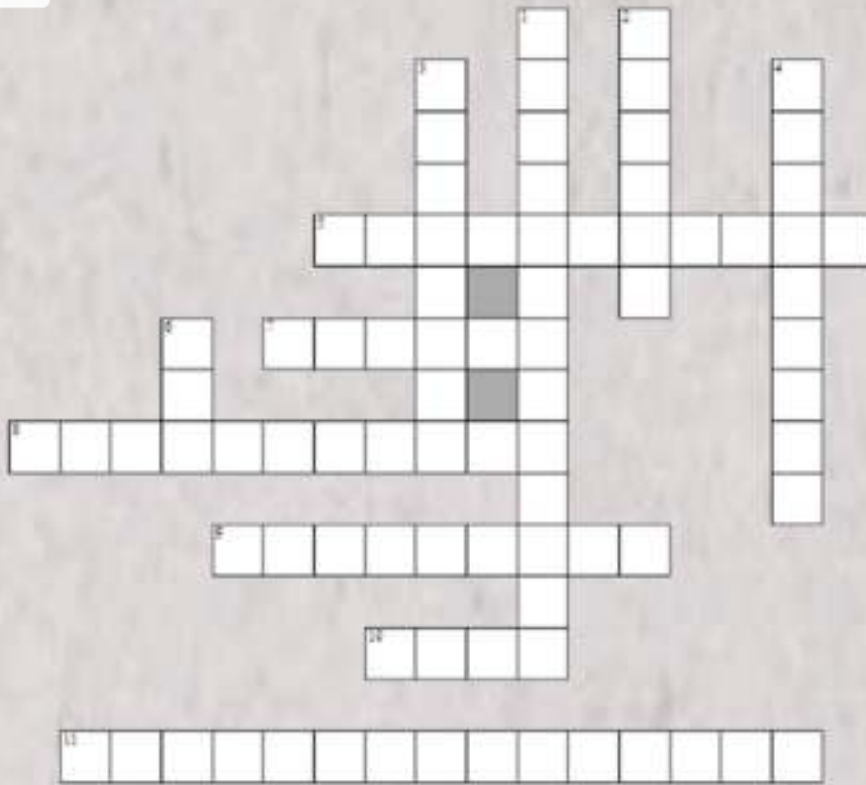

IS APPLE A POISON?

An apple is a sweet, edible fruit produced by an apple tree (*Malus pumila*). An apple tree is originated in Central Asia. Apples have been grown for thousands of years in Asia and Europe and were brought to North America by European colonist. Apples have religious and mythological significance in many cultures, including Norse, Greek and European Christian traditions. Apples are too tasty to eat, but as you bite deep into an apple, you are confronted with something not sweet in its core: tiny black seeds. Unlike the sweet tang of the fruit, the tiny black seeds have another story. They contain amygdalin, a substance that releases cyanide when it comes into contact with human digestive enzymes. But acute toxicity is rare if you accidentally eat some of the seeds. When we chew the seeds, amygdalin could be released in the body. However, large amounts can be dangerous. Most apple cores contain around 5 apple seeds, However, this amount will vary based on the health of the plant. Amygdalin is a part of the seeds' chemical defences is harmless when intact, but when the seeds are damaged, chewed or digested, amygdalin degrades into hydrogen cyanide. This is very poisonous and even lethal in high doses. Nothing to worry that about 200 grinded apple seeds (around a cup) only causes fatal for human body. It can even lead to coma and death in rare cases. It is well said that,

“AN APPLE A DAY, KEEPS THE DOCTOR AWAY”

Some benefits of eating apple are: they are rich in nutritions, good for weight loss, good for heart, they are linked to a lower risk of diabetes, promote good gut bacteria, prevents cancer, helps to fight asthma, good for bone health, protects from stomach injury, protects our brain. Thus, eat an apple everyday and lead a healthy life.

From where I am from, my parents would think to buy a brand new car when the neighbour buys it. We are influenced so much by external factors and start running in a race which was never meant for us.

Time is precious, yes. But you CAN also have time for yourself.

Taking leave on a weekday to spend some own time isn't wrong. It doesn't mean you are 'less productive'.

Every person has a different sand clock within them. It doesn't have to be the same.

This part is for the crew who feels they are 'slow' in what they do. Everyone has a clock running inside them. Some people believe quality is more crucial than meeting deadlines and some opt for the other. Other times, there is a compromise between both.

We differ, but that doesn't mean that we aren't good in what we do.

A Story to make you understand better.

Let's consider two people- Nina and Barry. Both are given a task-to create a website with a login page using Angular. Their level of knowledge is more or less the same.

Nina goes to the main documentation, learns a lot about Angular and its functions. She then does the work. It takes her 2 weeks to complete the task.

Barry learns the basics for two to three days and starts doing the project. He finishes the task in 1 week.

Now, Nina is bound to feel incompetent as she thinks she isn't capable enough.

Some days later, an error throws up in the application. It seems to be related to Angular.

Nina knows how to solve it because she could analyse the root cause after heavily going through the documentation. Barry, on the other hand has to learn a lot before he decides to approach the problem.

So this is where the time clock varies. You aren't potentially similar to another individual. Taking your own time is good for you in the long run. It isn't going to weigh you down. It doesn't mean you aren't productive enough. And even if someone says you aren't productive all the time, don't worry. No one can devote all their time to work, even if they wanted to. The people who do work, never boasts.

சட்டம் இயற்றி, 30 ஆண்டுகளுக்கு மேலாகிவிட்டது. இன்றளவும் அதை நாம் கருத்தில் கொள்ளவில்லை. வரும் 2030ல் மோசமான தண்ணீர் பற்றாக்குறையையும், 2050ல் தண்ணீர் பற்றாக்குறையின் உச்சத்தையும் நம் நாடு காணவுள்ளதாக புள்ளிவிவரங்கள் தெளிவுபடுத்தியுள்ளன. எதிர்கால சந்ததிகளை கருத்தில் கொண்டு, மக்களும், அரசும் ஒருங்கிணைந்து ஆக்கபூர்வ நீர் மேலாண்மை செயல்பாடுகளை மேற்கொள்ளவேண்டும். நீங்கள் சேமிக்கும் தண்ணீர், உலகப்போர் தவிர்க்கும் என்பதை நினைவில் கொள்ளுங்கள்!

It is a Group-3 Forum held on 17th march 2019. Four members from our club participated and enjoyed the event.





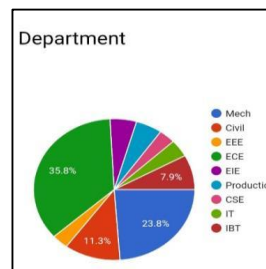
