Objective:

The primary objective of the "Plastic-Free Maruthamalai" campaign was to create awarenessabout the environmental hazards of plastic pollution and to promote a cleaner, plastic-free environment in the Maruthamalai foothills.

Activities Conducted:

Clean-up Drive:
