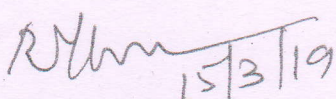
Agenda 6: Governance, Leadership and Management

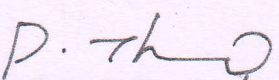
