

**MADRAS HIGH COURT
RIGHT TO INFORMATION
(REGULATION OF FEE AND COST)
RULES, 2007**

[R.O.C. No.2636-A/06/F1 - SRO C -3/2008]. - In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 28 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (Central Act 22 of 2005), the Chief Justice of the High Court of Madras hereby makes the following Rules :-

1. Short title and commencement. - (i) These rules may be called "Madras High Court Right to Information (Regulation of Fee and Cost) Rules, 2007".

¹ [(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions. - In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires, -

(a) "Act" means the Right to Information Act, 2005 (Central Act 22 of 2005).

(b) "section" means Section of the Act;

(c) all other words and expressions used in these Rules but not defined in the Act shall have the same meaning assigned to them in the Act.

3. Fees. - Every application for obtaining information under sub-section (1) of Section 6 of the Act shall be accompanied by an application fee of Rupees Ten.
